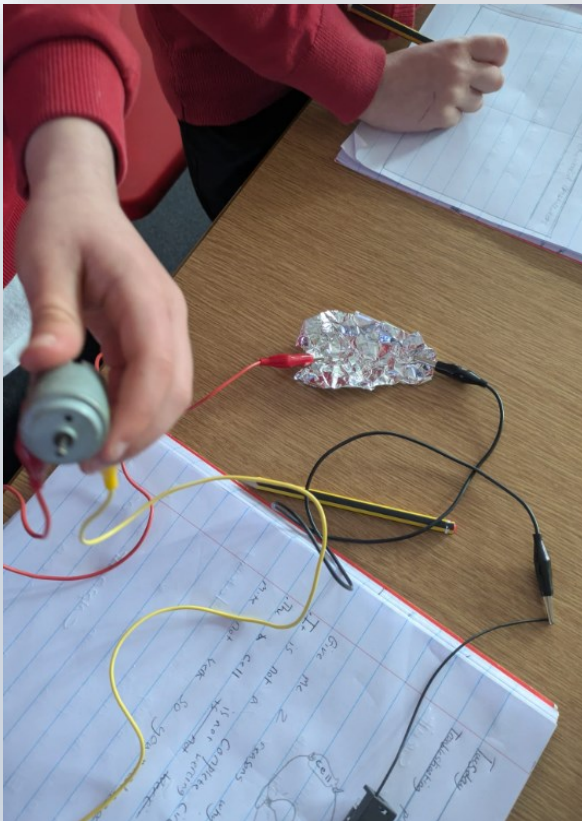
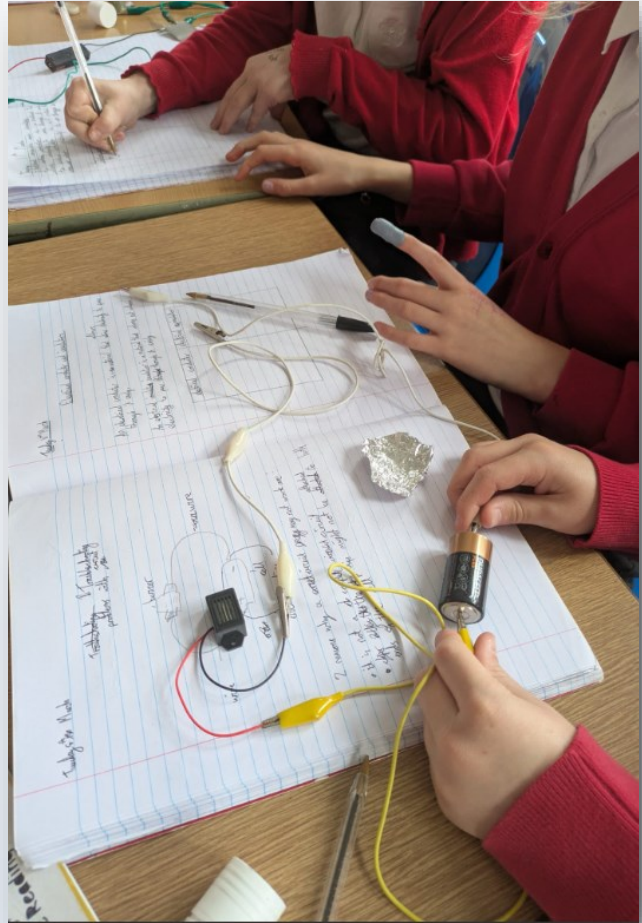

Ladywell explored conductors and insulators this week. They tested various materials to find out whether they would conduct electricity.

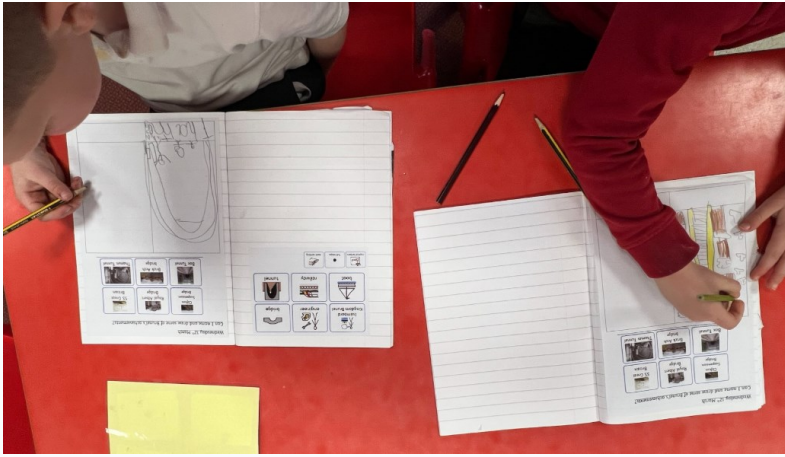
Year 4 created picture frames in Forest School, they used square lashing to secure the corners. They then used natural materials to make self-portraits. They also used the fire to make popcorn to share.





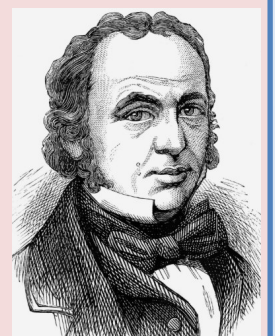

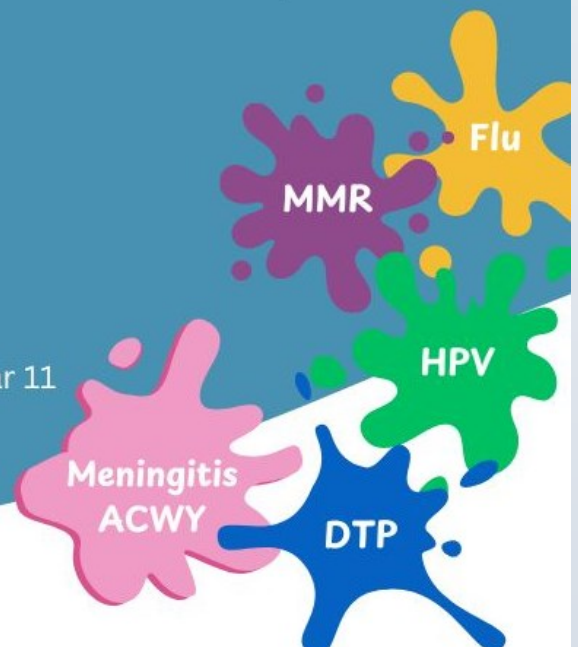

# 1

I'm a single parent of one child and we want to go on holiday for a week.

Your holiday will not be authorised and you must talk to the school before you book anything.  
Because your child will miss 5 school days you will be given a penalty notice fine.  
The fine is £160 but if you pay it in 21 days it will be reduced to £80.

FOR EVERY CHILD A PENALTY IS GIVEN.

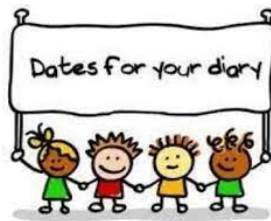


## 3RD TIME
