It was hot work in both our P.E. Sessions this week, the children have started a unit on athletics and have shown great determination in learning the skills required to be an athlete.



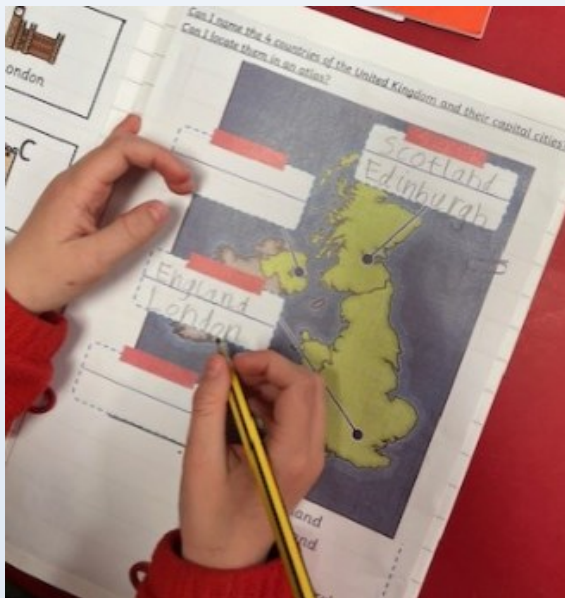

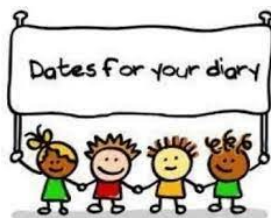
