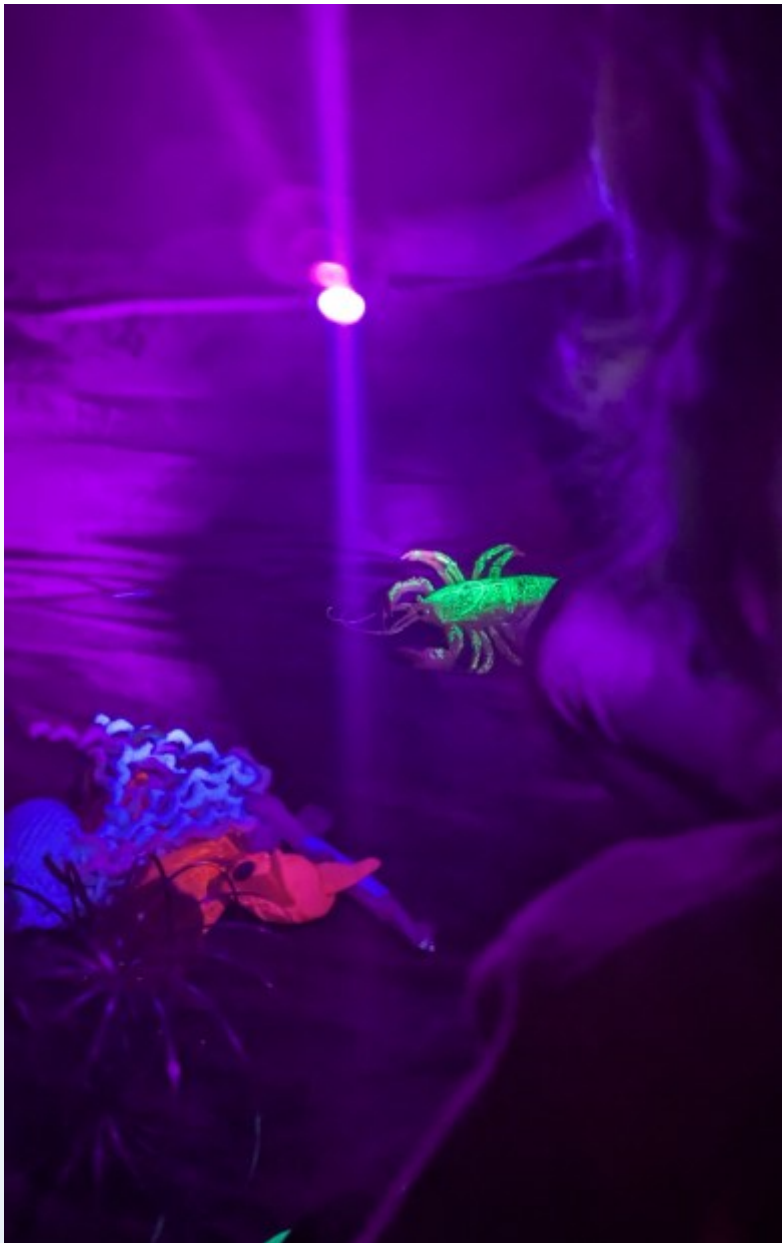

Dear Ugborough families,

We do understand the large cost difference when you take a holiday during school term and that it is tempting to do so. We would like to reiterate the importance of children being in school each day to ensure they keep up to date with all learning that happens. It is very difficult, within the curriculum planning schedule, to find the time during the school day to spend with the children who have missed blocks of learning. If you do decide to take a holiday during term time, please obtain an Absence Request form from the office. We do kindly ask that you are honest with us about holidays and not call in to report your child as ill. Children tend to be very excited about holidays and tell their friends, and very often staff, and it puts them (and us) in a rather difficult position if they are being encouraged to not be truthful.

We appreciate your co-operation with this.

## WHAT THE NEW RULES MEAN FOR ME

I'm a single parent of one child and we want to go on holiday for a week.

Your holiday will not be authorised and you must talk to the school before you book anything.

Because your child will miss 5 school days you will be given a penalty notice fine.

The fine is £160 but if you pay it in 21 days it will be reduced to £80.

A penalty notice fine will not be given. Instead, your case will be taken to court.

A magistrate can fine each parent £2500 for each child

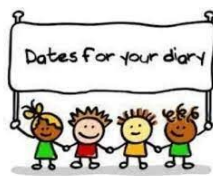
