In Year 4 this week, we have been studying the properties of 2D shape.

This took our learning outside and we experimented with creating mathematically accurate versions of quadrilaterals.





We learned about the different symbols used to show parallel lines, same length lines, same size angles and right angles.

We were also able to identify: Obtuse, acute and reflex angles.





We had to be accurate with our mathematical symbols - ask us why!

In year 2 we have been learning about millilitres and litres in maths. We took our learning outside this week and had a go at accurately measuring out different amounts of water into varying sizes of beakers.




