

Year 2: We have also been looking at estimating numbers on a number line. We had number lines with different start and end numbers on the playground. We then picked a number and we had to stand where our number would be on the number line as accurately as possible. We had to explain why we had placed ourselves where we did, making sure we used our maths reasoning skills.







Continuing with their understanding of place value, year 4 have been thinking what columns we need to consider when we are ordering 4 digit numbers.

In science we have been investigating our senses. This week we had to try some different foods; strawberries, salty crisps and lemon. We predicted what they might taste like and which we would like the best and least. We tested our predictions. We were right, the lemon was our least favourite!

In PE, Ladywell have been continuing to develop their rugby skills. In this particular game, children had to be able to work quickly and cooperatively as a team whilst running and holding the ball to deliver it back to their home station.
