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
In Year 1 science we have been exploring the meaning of omnivore, carnivore and herbivore. We had a go at sorting different animals into the three groups. We had to explain why we grouped them as we did. We also drew our favourite animal and gave it the correct label.



#### Year 2 Science

This week in science we were discussing the importance of exercise for humans. We conducted an experiment. We looked at a range of activities and decided which one would raise our heart rate and which one would not. We made our predictions before putting it to

the test! We did our exercises for 45 seconds and checked our pulse before and after each exercise to see if it was faster. We talked about our results and why it was faster or not much faster. We also talked about how to make it a fair test.








