The competition will be judged and prizes awarded for the following categories:

- Most Likely To Scare the Birds
- Best Recycled Scarecrow
- Best Overall Scarecrow


All schools who submit an entry will be entitled to one school County Show entry permit which will be issued free of charge for up to ten children and three teachers to visit the show on Thursday or Friday whenever a school booking is made. All scarecrows submitted will be displayed at the Devon County Show (30th June, 1st & 2nd July).

Competition Rules:

- Schools may make multiple entries but only one entry per category and a label should be firmly attached to each scarecrow identifying the school and category.
- Scarecrows should either be free standing or made so they can be attached to a fence post.
- Not to exceed 2m tall, 900mm wide.
- Can be left outside for 7 days (to be collected by school 4th–8th July 2022, or if not they will be donated to Farmwise and may be displayed at future Farmwise events).
- All other scarecrows need to be delivered to Westpoint between 8am–6pm on 28th or 29th June 2022 to be judged on 30th June 2022.

All competition entries need to be confirmed to FarmwiseDevon@norsegroup.co.uk by the 19th June 2022 identifying the name of the school and class.
