Science Day with Wonderstruck!

Thanks to our Wonderful PTA, on Monday we had an all-day science day, beginning with a BANG! Peter from Wonderstruck was in showing us all about forces and motion he exploded gun powder in a big bowl of rice pops cereal; he set off gas (LOUD) and methane rockets; he even lay on a bed of nails and had Mrs Mann SMASH a block with a sledge hammer (this was scary but he was fine). All of this demonstrated how forces can make things move - and in the case of the nails, how spreading a force over a large area, reduces its effects.

We then made our own rockets and shot them ACROSS the school field. The winning rockets went from the far end (by the road) all the way to the forest school log circle! In the afternoon, KS2 made fan-powered cars and raced them for glory.

Fun and inclusive football and multi-sport activities for children aged 7-15 with a disability and educational health


