


In maths this week, Year 2 have revisited addition and subtraction. We enjoyed practising our skills on the tables!

In science in Year 1 we have started learning about plants. In Year 2 we are revisiting our learning from Year 1 and building on this learning this term. In both classes we have set up some experiments to see what plants need to grow. We have some cress seeds in sunlight with and without water and we have some seeds in the dark with and without water. We will check on the seeds each week to see which are growing and which are not. In Year 2 we have made some predictions about which plant we think will grow the best and why and which will not grow and why.



This week in science, Ladywell have begun their unit on rocks. We started by recapping what we already know about the different physical properties of materials and then handled/made observational drawings of a variety of rock specimens, grouping them based on their attributes. Children quickly noticed the similarities between coal, sandstone and chalk (all sedimentary and all of which left quite a lot of dust deposits on our hands and tables). We also explored how some of the rocks' properties can be useful in everyday life e.g. chalk for writing and drawing and slate for roof tiles.









This week year 4 have working on understanding what happens when we divide one-digit and two-digit numbers by 10. They created a human place value chart and moved the digits to the required column.

A water safety talk from the RNLI lifeguards gave the children invaluable strategies to help them if they find themselves or somebody else in danger at the beach.

Foundation Stage (Hillhead) Tuesdays


Year 1 & 2 Fridays
